- As of 2023 the region's population **declined by 3.3%** since 2018, falling by 31,703. Population is expected to **decrease by 3.3%** between 2023 and 2028, losing 30,501.
- From 2018 to 2023, jobs declined by 3.9% in Milwaukee County, WI from 538,237 to 517,176. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 4.5% by 8.4%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate increased from 63.3% to 64.9% between 2018 and 2023.
- Concerning educational attainment, **21.1% of Milwaukee County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (the same as the national average), and **8.3% hold an Associate's Degree** (0.6% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2023 are General Medical and Surgical Hospitals, Restaurants and Other Eating Places, and Individual and Family Services.




Oct 2024 Labor Force Breakdown



Educational Attainment









Unemployment by Ethnicity








Job Trends




Milwaukee County, WI had an October 2024 unemployment rate of 3.34%, decreasing from 3.83% 5 years before.




Millennials

Milwaukee County, WI has 211,114 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 186,158.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is low in Milwaukee County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 276,580 people 55 or older, while there are 242,284 here.




Racial Diversity

Milwaukee County, WI has 9.97 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.6 per 1,000 people.




Property Crime










Top Industry Employment Concentration








Top Industry GRP






