#### **Takeaways**

- As of 2023 the region's population increased by 2.0% since 2018, growing by 2,656. Population is expected to increase by 1.3% between 2023 and 2028, adding 1,771.
- From 2018 to 2023, jobs increased by 1.8% in Washington County, WI from 62,931 to 64,062. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 3.9% by 2.1%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate decreased from 71.0% to 68.0% between 2018 and 2023.
- Concerning educational attainment, 23.5% of Washington County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree (2.3% above the national average), and 12.5% hold an Associate's Degree (3.6% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2023 are Restaurants and Other Eating Places, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals.













## **Job Trends**






Washington County, WI had a February 2024 unemployment rate of 2.78%, increasing from 2.72% 5 years before.




#### **Millennials**

Washington County, WI has 22,888 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 27,997.




#### **Retiring Soon**

Retirement risk is high in Washington County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 41,263 people 55 or older, while there are 49,395 here.




#### **Racial Diversity**

Washington County, WI has 1.07 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.6 per 1,000 people.




#### **Property Crime**








#### **Top Industry Employment Concentration**








