### Takeaways

- As of 2023 the region's population increased by 1.9% since 2018, growing by 2,553. Population is expected to increase by 1.2% between 2023 and 2028, adding 1,642.
- From 2018 to 2023, jobs increased by 2.2% in Washington County, WI from 62,931 to 64,286. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 4.5% by 2.3%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate decreased from 71.0% to 68.7% between 2018 and 2023.
- Concerning educational attainment, 23.5% of Washington County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree (2.3% above the national average), and 12.5% hold an Associate's Degree (3.7% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2023 are Restaurants and Other Eating Places, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals.

### **Educational Attainment**














### **Unemployment Rate Trends**

Washington County, WI had an October 2024 unemployment rate of 2.17%, decreasing from 2.74% 5 years before.












#### **Top Industry Employment Concentration**






### **Top Occupation Employment Concentration**






Median Hourly Earnings
