





- >Food Waste












•••• What is a Sustainable Food System?






The Need for Regional Food System Planning

How food pantries perpetuate food inequities and poor nutrition (need for systemic change).

I am also wondering about how we can ensure regional and cross-regional coordination.

It would be great to have an even greater emphasis on the positive impact of healthy food on the immune system

How can you target the criticality of organic (to preserve environment, and provide safety for humans and protect ecosystems?

Are there youth/summer programs involving farming, groves, etc.? That may be a fun program to connect youth.

I think that all of the "components" you listed throughout the survey are important to consider as a plan is created. I also think it is critical to involve as many people - stakeholders - in this process as possible.

...of paramount importance, which I just was learning about at a webinar called "Examining Whiteness in the Food System," is the need to look at radical transformative solutions. Rather than framing around food access, framing around food sovereignty

Changing social norms around food and health to reduce the consumption of junk foods.


