

014-23-728 - Installation of Public EV Charging Stations at 50+ Locations in Milwaukee County as Identified in Milwaukee's Preliminary EV Readiness Plan

Project Description

The City of Milwaukee was awarded nearly \$15 million in Federal discretionary funds to install EV chargers at 50+ sites countywide. During the site selection process, the city prioritized sites in areas that lacked existing EV infrastructure, low-to-moderate income communities, and neighborhoods with high ratios of multi-family housing units. This project will support the city’s climate and equity goals by expanding the network in areas that currently lack public infrastructure, or lack the ability to charge at home, making residents more comfortable with switching to an EV, and increasing rates of EV adoption. Locations will be finalized after additional public engagement and technical review of sites.
