## TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM FOR SOUTHEASTERN WISCONSIN: 2025-2028

This transportation improvement program (TIP) is the thirty-third such program prepared for the Southeastern Wisconsin Region. The TIP is a Federally required listing of all arterial highway and public transit improvement projects proposed to be carried out by State and local governments over the next four years (2025-2028) in the seven-county Southeastern Wisconsin Region.

The TIP was developed under the guidance of the Southeastern Wisconsin Regional Planning Commission's Advisory Committees on Transportation System Planning and Programming for the Kenosha, Milwaukee, Racine, Round Lake Beach, and West Bend Urbanized Areas, and close cooperation with municipal, county, and State transportation implementation agencies. The rosters of these committees are listed in Appendix F of this report. Map 1 shows the Southeastern Wisconsin Region and the approved adjusted boundaries for the five Census-defined urbanized areas within the Region. The TIP contains 513 projects within the Region for the four-year programming period of 2025 through 2028. The TIP represents a total potential investment in transportation improvements and services of \$3.5 billion. Of this total, \$2.0 billion, or about 57.8 percent, is proposed to be provided in Federal aids; \$1.03 billion or about 29.0 percent, in State funds; and \$467 million, or about 13.2 percent, in local monies. Table 1 summarizes the total funds required to implement the projects located in each of the seven counties in Southeastern Wisconsin within each of the four years of the TIP.

## The key elements of the TIP are:

- 1. 2025-2028 TIP project listing (included as part of this document)
- 2. 2023-2026 TIP project status
- 3. Fiscal Constraint Analysis
- 4. Contribution of 2025-2028 TIP projects towards achieving VISION 2050 performance goals and National performance measure targets
- 5. Equity Analysis of the 2025-2028 TIP
- 6. Public comment summary on draft 2025-2028 TIP

With the 2025-2028 TIP, all of these elements will be available from the Commission's website at www.sewrpc.org/TIP. In addition, to the generalized listing of projects included in this document, an electronic version of the TIP is also available from the Commission's TIP webpage that includes more detailed information on each project listed.

Federal regulations require that transit and arterial highway improvement projects within the seven-county Southeastern Wisconsin Region be included in this TIP if these projects are to be eligible for capital or operating Federal funding. The program also includes non-Federally funded transit and arterial highway projects within the Region. The program provides information to identify each project; shows estimated total costs and the estimated amounts of Federal, State, and local funds proposed to be obligated during the program period against those costs; designates the proposed type of Federal funds to be used by the project;

and identifies the State and local agencies responsible for carrying out each project. Federal regulations also require that the TIP be determined to be consistent with the adopted regional transportation plan and be approved by the Regional Planning Commission as the Metropolitan Planning Organization for the urbanized areas in Southeastern Wisconsin. Approval by the Governor of the State of Wisconsin, or his designee, the Secretary of the Wisconsin Department of Transportation, is also required. Specifically, the Southeastern Wisconsin TIP must be approved by the State and incorporated into the Statewide transportation improvement program, which is submitted by WisDOT to the Federal Transit Administration and Federal Highway Administration for approval and potential funding action by these agencies.

The TIP by definition indicates the transportation improvement priorities of State and local governments by their program of projects for implementation in each of the four years of the program. The TIP represents a stage of implementation of VISION 2050—the year 2050 regional land use and transportation plan.¹ The TIP includes an assessment of how the projects programmed contribute to the achievement of both the VISION 2050 transportation performance goals and the targets established for the National performance measure (NPM). The TIP also includes a demonstration that available funding sources are adequate to implement the TIP by comparing total TIP costs and revenues for the program period. Federal regulations allow projects eligible for a particular Federal and State funding source, but that are not approved for such funding, to be illustratively listed in the TIP for informational purposes. Illustrative projects would be added to the TIP, and included in the assessment of available funding, should they be approved for the Federal or State funds being sought.

## THE 2025 THROUGH 2028 TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM

Tables A.1 through A.7 presents a project-by-project listing of the TIP for each county. Sufficient information is provided to identify the type of project; the termini and length of the project; the estimated total cost and amount of Federal, State, and local funds proposed to be obligated during the program year<sup>2</sup>; the proposed Federal funding program; and the recipient or agency responsible for implementing the project. Each table is structured to indicate the TIP projects listed by order of implementing agency and, for each implementing agency, in twelve categories: highway system preservation, highway system improvement, highway system expansion, transit system preservation, transit system improvement, transit system expansion, bicycle/pedestrian preservation, bicycle/pedestrian improvement, bicycle/pedestrian expansion, highway safety, environmental enhancement, and off-system highway. Descriptions of each category are provided below.

- <u>Highway Preservation</u>: Projects that result in little or no increase in the traffic-carrying capacity of the
  existing arterial street system, but are necessary to maintain existing capacity and structural adequacy
  of the arterial facility for which the project is proposed. These projects which are described as
  resurfacing or reconstruction may also provide bicycle and pedestrian accommodations and
  incorporate modernization of the existing arterial facility to address safety and other concerns, by
  including intersection improvements, shoulder widening, and vertical and horizontal alignment
  improvements.
- <u>Highway Improvement</u>: Projects generally involve roadway reconstruction (similar to highway preservation), but also include in the reconstruction an increase in the traffic carrying capacity of the existing arterial highway system, typically through the addition of traffic lanes.



- <u>Highway Expansion</u>: Projects that increase the traffic carrying capacity of the arterial highway system through development of new arterial streets or highways.
- <u>Transit Preservation</u>: Projects that are necessary to maintain the current quality and level of service on the existing transit system.
- <u>Transit Improvement:</u> Projects that improve the quality and level of service on the existing transit system.
- <u>Transit Expansion</u>: Projects that either expand the existing transit system or create new transit systems or subsystems.
- <u>Bicycle/Pedestrian Preservation:</u> Projects that maintain the current quality of existing bicycle/pedestrian facilities along arterial streets and highways or on adjacent roadway corridors or off-roadway locations through resurfacing and reconstruction.
- <u>Bicycle/Pedestrian Improvement:</u> Projects that enhance existing bicycle facilities along arterial streets and highways or improve bicycle and pedestrian safety within roadways and at intersections.
- <u>Bicycle/Pedestrian Expansion:</u> Projects that expand the existing bicycle/pedestrian network or create new on-and off-street bicycle/pedestrian facilities.
- <u>Highway Safety</u>: Projects designed to improve or eliminate existing unsafe conditions on the Federal aid highway system, as it currently exists, and are candidates for special Federal safety program funding.
- <u>Environmental Enhancement</u>: Projects that can reduce air, noise, or visual pollution, and provide some benefit to highway system operation or capacity.
- <u>Highway Off-System</u>: Projects on streets or highways that are not on the arterial street and highway system and are candidates for special Federal funding.

Figure 1 graphically presents the proposed expenditures for the project types within the four years of the TIP. Certain expenditure patterns are apparent from an examination of Figure 1. These include the following:

- A significant portion of financial resources programmed for 2025-2028 are to be devoted to the
  preservation of the existing transportation facilities and services—both highway and transit—about
  \$2.4 billion, or 67 percent of expenditures in the Region. This allocation of resources does not involve
  routine highway operations and maintenance activities—snowplowing, ice control, grass cutting, and
  power for traffic control and street lighting.
- The expenditures for highway improvement in 2025-2028 are approximately \$968.4 million, or 27 percent of total expenditures. A vast majority of these funds—over 98 percent—are programmed for the reconstruction of IH 94 between N. 70th Street and N. 16th Street. (It should be noted that much of the cost of a highway improvement project is due to the reconstruction of the existing highway facility. The cost of additional traffic lanes provided may only represent 10 to 20 percent of the total costs of a highway improvement project.) In 2025, no expenditures are programmed for highway expansion projects.

• About \$791.8 million, or 22 percent of the total financial resources in 2025-2028, is devoted to public transit projects. Of the total year 2025 programmed resources for public transit, \$779.4 million, or 98 percent, is for preservation and \$12.4 million, or two percent, is for service expansion.
